Notice to Students

Most courses will require someone acting as a “contact person” at the course location. The contact person(s) agree to secure a location for the course and collect names and fees before a course can be offered. Should the course not proceed, all fees will be returned. If a course goes forward, there will be no refund should a student drop out. We require our funds collected before the course proceeds and have broken the numbers for a course from 1-10 for one instructor and from 11-20 for two instructors. The cost for 10 students is \$3,300 plus the manual, and for 11-20 students the cost is \$6,500 plus the manual. For example, if 10 students registered the cost per student is \$330. Should only 5 register and they still want a course, the cost would be \$660 .The same ratios apply to all courses.

Should you wish to have a course in your area and act as the contact person, please contact our office. We will set a date and forward resource materials. If enough students are interested and pay the fees we will have a course in your area.

Students must attend all sessions in order to complete the course. Decide which format you require for a course: evenings Monday to Friday and all day Saturday; or 10-hour days Friday to Sunday. All students are expected to take part in the hands-on skinning portion of the course. Gloves, safety equipment, and instruction are provided. Do not register for the course if you do not wish to actively take part.

The instructor(s) are the final judge in determining if a student has successfully completed the course. They also have the option of delivering a test during the course to ensure all standards have been met.

These courses are informative, dynamic, and exciting. Unlike some courses that have to be renewed every second year or so, the instruction will stay with the student for life. This consideration should be factored in when considering what you will be getting for your tuition.
